

## **Parallels between the raising of Jairus' daughter and the healing of the long suffering woman**

1. Both stories show that Jesus is concerned about women
2. The girl is 12 years old - v. 42; the woman suffered for 12 years - v. 25
3. Jairus falls at Jesus' feet - v. 22; the woman falls at Jesus' feet - v. 33 (and the story of Legion - v. 6)
4. In both there is a concern for healing/salvation - v. 23; vs. 28, 34
5. Jairus is told not to fear - v. 36; the woman is afraid after she is found out - v. 33
6. In both faith is emphasized - v. 34; v. 36
7. Both involve ritual impurity (and the story of Legion)
