

Jesus walks on water

Mark 6:46-53

A. Jesus on land, a mountain, disciples on the sea: ⁴⁶And after he had taken leave of them, he went up on the mountain to pray. ⁴⁷And when evening came, the boat was out on the sea, and he was alone on the land.

B. The disciples struggle: ⁴⁸And he saw that they were making headway painfully,

C. Wind against them: for the wind was against them.

D. Jesus came to them: And about the fourth watch of the night he came to them, walking on the sea.

E. A ghost/disciples terrified: He meant to pass by them, ⁴⁹but when they saw him walking on the sea they thought it was a ghost, and cried out, ⁵⁰for they all saw him and were terrified.

E¹. It is I/don't be afraid: But immediately he spoke to them and said, "Take heart; it is I. Do not be afraid."

D¹. Jesus with them in the boat ⁵¹And he got into the boat with them,

C¹. Wind ceases: and the wind ceased.

B¹. The disciples struggle: And they were utterly astounded, ⁵²for they did not understand about the loaves, but their hearts were hardened.

A¹. All crossed the sea, all on land: ⁵³When they had crossed over, they came to land at Gennesaret and moored to the shore.
