

Ministry around the Sea of Galilee and in Nazareth

Mark 4:35-6:56

(Inclusion: 4:35-36 - in a boat, to the other side, left the crowd)

A. Jesus on the sea of Galilee: He subdues a storm - 4:37-41

B. Exorcism on the other side: Casting out 5,000+ demons - 5:1-20

(Inclusion: 5:21 - in a boat, to the other side, crowd gathers)

C. Two stories on the west side:

- a) Jairus' daughter - Mark 5:22-24a;
- b) the long suffering woman - Mark 5:24b-32
- a¹) Jairus' daughter - Mark 5:33-43

D. Rejection at Nazareth - Mark 6:1-6

C¹. Two stories on the west side:

- a) Apostles sent out to do kingdom work - Mark 6:7-13
- b) Herod kills John - Mark 6:14-29
- a¹) Apostles return and seek rest - Mark 6:30-32

(Inclusion: 6:33-34 - Crowds recognize Jesus, ran/all the towns, Jesus teaches them)

B¹. Miracle on the other side: Feeding the 5,000+ - Mark 6:33-44

A¹. Jesus on the sea of Galilee: He walks on water - Mark 6:45-53

(Inclusion: 6:54-56 - Crowds recognize Jesus, ran/whole region, Jesus heals them)

- A and A¹ - Jesus' power over the waters; the wind ceased; overcoming fear.
 - B and B¹ - amazing miracles on the East side involving the number 5,000 (a Roman legion is 5,000 plus, the crowd was 5,000 plus any women or children).
 - C and C¹ - C has a ruler, 2 women and an emphasis on the number 12; C¹ has a king, 2 women in the Herod story and the 12 apostles. Both involve intercalation (a story within a story).
